

The following three continuing education modules are required for every paramedic in the State of Michigan. The Michigan Department of Community Health EMS division is requiring that all Advance Life Support vehicles will carry the new MI-MEDIC cards. The MI-MEDIC cards were developed to assist each ALS provider in pediatric drug administration and the prevention of pediatric medication errors. Inservice education has been developed to assist in the roll out of this new tool. The required CE modules are FREE to access and must be completed within your license period.
