***Free Standing Surgical Outpatient Facility Emergency Department,  
Hospital Provider-Based Emergency Department and Hospital Based  
Care Facility Criteria For On Line Medical Control MCA Endorsement  
Criteria for MCA Endorsement***

The participation of Online Medical Control Free Standing Surgical Outpatient Facility Emergency Department, Hospital Provider-Based Emergency Department or Hospital Based Care Facility in the HEMS MCA, under the direction of HEMS, will be considered with reference to the criteria set forth.

As an Online Medical Control Free Standing Surgical Outpatient Facility Emergency Department, Hospital Provider-Based Emergency Department or Hospital Based Care Facility, you are required to provide timely emergency care 24 hours a day, 7 days a week.

All Online Medical Control Free Standing Surgical Outpatient Facility Emergency Department, Hospital Provider-Based Emergency Department or Hospital Based Care Facility must meet the requirements set forth in the annual letter of compliance. All initial applicants must submit a cover letter expressing request for participation in the HEMS MCA with support documentation to substantiate that they meet the criteria outlined in the letter of compliance.

Requests for Free-Standing Surgical Outpatient Facility Emergency Department, Hospital Provider-Based Emergency Department or Hospital Based Care Facility participation will be based on the requirements outlined in PA 375 of 2000 and in addition Provider-Based Emergency Department participation must have obtained the conditions found in 42 CFR 482.1 – 482.45.

Acceptance into the HEMS MCA is ultimately determined by the HEMS Medical Control Authority through recommendation of the Medical Control Advisory Board based on compliance and bylaw requirements.
