## Asphyxiants - Simple

FORMS: Carbon Dioxide (CO2), Nitrogen, Helium, Methane and Propane Gas

ROUTES OF EXPOSURE: Inhalation displaces oxygen in the normal environment causing hypoxia, hypercapnia or other potentially incapacitating condition.

SIGNS AND SYMPTOMS:

CNS: Altered mental status, stupor, lethargy and coma.

Cardiorespiratory: Respiratory or cardiopulmonary arrest due to hypoxia.

## **Pre-Medical Control**

**PARAMEDIC** 

- 1. Follow General HAZMAT Treatment protocol.
- 2. Administer oxygen 10-15 L via non-rebreather mask or BVM.
- 3. Follow Emergency Airway Procedure.
