Magnesium Sulfate

Indications:

Seizure prevention or control in severe pre-eclampsia or eclampsia. Severe asthma exacerbation.

Administration:

Maintain drip per sending facility orders.

Contra-indications:

Do not give in toxemia of pregnancy during the 2 hours preceding delivery.

Adverse Effects:

Flushing, sweating, hypotension, depressed reflexes, respiratory paralysis, increased PR interval, heart block.

If adverse effects occur terminate administration and contact the sending facility for direction. If sending facility is unavailable contact medical control.
