- 1. 8.17 (S2) Additional Equipment and Training- Addition of Video Laryngoscope and Spit Hood to list of additional equipment
- 2. 5.3 Tachycardia- Joule guidelines for cardioversion
- 3. 8.32 Ambulance Transport of Operational Canines- new protocol for transport of a K9 dog. HEMS is looking into training for management of a K9 dog
- 4. 9.5 IV Ancillary Supply Exchange- Addition of lactated ringers for hospital IV exchange
- 5. 8.15 Interfacility Patient Transfers- changed to language for BLS transfers. What they can and cannot transport with approval of agency and training.
- 6. 4.5 Pediatric Respiratory Distress, Failure or Arrest- #3 is new addition to refer to Pediatric Crashing Patient protocol if needed. #10 if needed start treatment on scene and then initiate transport. Do not delay transport unless you need to treat to stabilize the patient.
- 7. 9.8 Naloxone Leave Behind Medication Kit Contents and Distribution Procedure-added the labeling requirements from the State. Please make sure all kits are labeled per the protocol.
- 8. 9.24 Fentanyl- Medication protocol to match the changes to the Pain Management Protocol.
- 9. 7.13 Pain Management- Fentanyl administration for adults is rounded up to the nearest dose of 25, 50, 75, 100 mcg. Adults is now everyone >14 years of age or older. Removed the half dose for adults 65 or older.
- 10. 7.9 (S2) Bougie- new protocol to allow for the use of a bougie device for difficult intubations and with your video laryngoscope.
